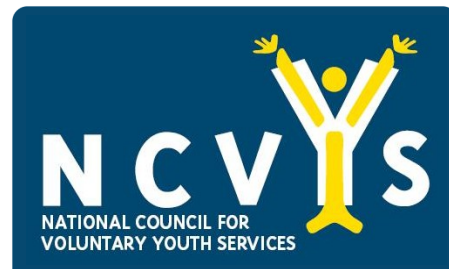


Keep the Faith; an inter-faith seminar
